We are excited to start up our Book of the Month Club again this school year. The club is a reading initiative for students in grades K-4. Here is how you and your child can get involved:

How it works

Monthly Books: Each month, we will highlight a new children's book. Your child can read it on their own, with friends, or together with you.

Reading Options: You can check out a limited number of copies from the school library or access the book in various ways:

- visit the public library
- purchase a copy from Amazon or a local bookstore
- download an electronic copy to a tablet or device
- download an audio version to listen to

Brag Tags

Earn rewards: For each book read (September through May), students will earn a commemorative brag tag

Participation: Students can read all 9 books or just the ones that interest them. Books will span different genres and formats, including fiction, nonfiction, chapter books, picture books, and graphic novels.

Monthly gatherings

Events: Each month, we will host a special gathering for students who have read the book. The event will include activities, discussions, a treat, and distribution of brag tags.
